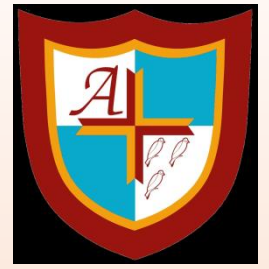

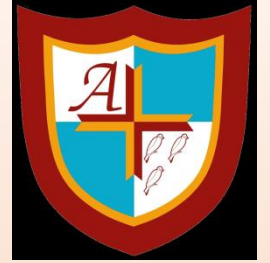

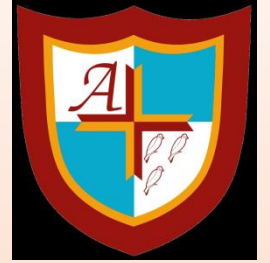

Attendance



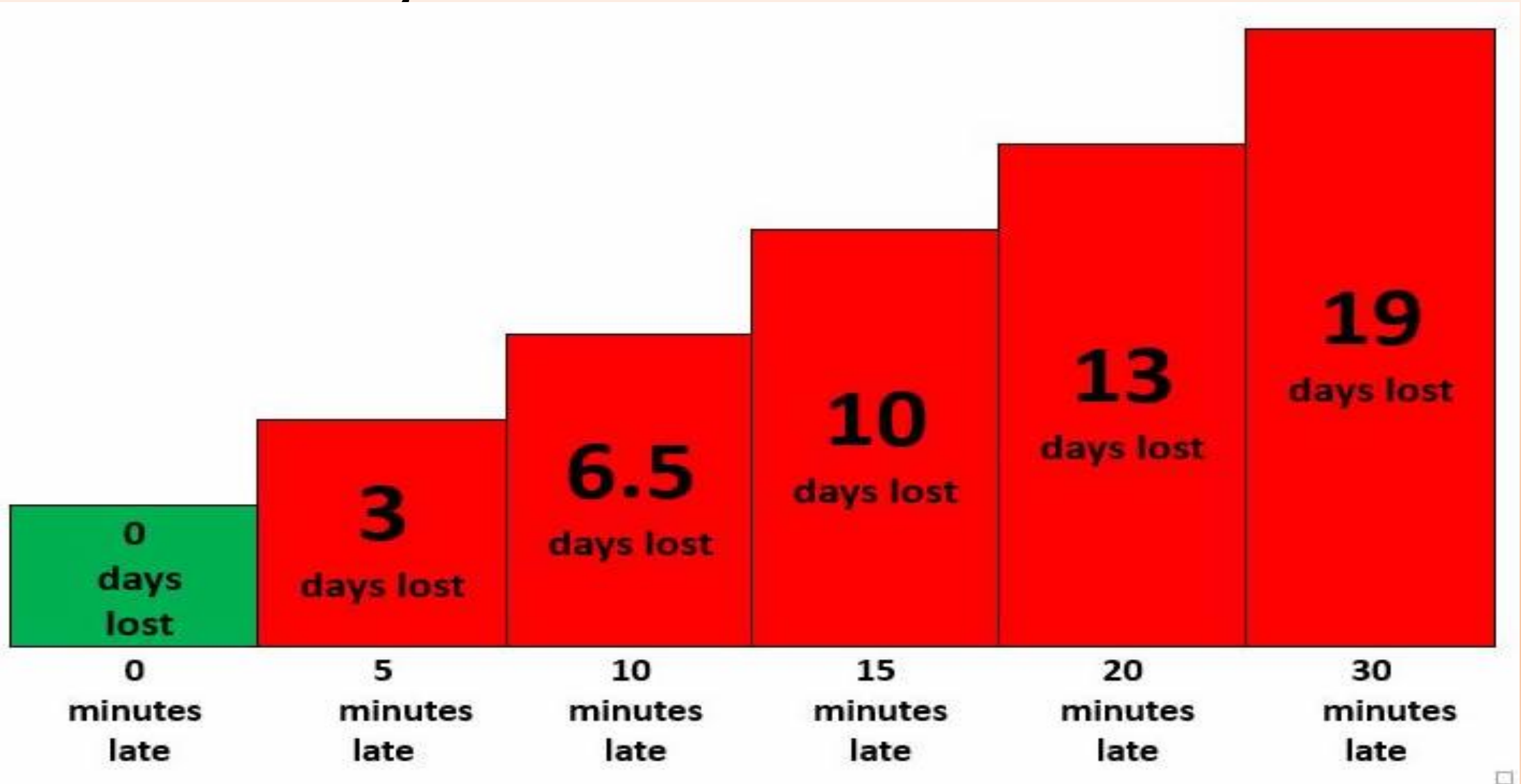
What is expected attendance ?

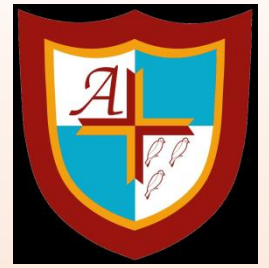

Our new spelling scheme Ready Steady Spell is being introduced from Y2- Y6 starting this week.



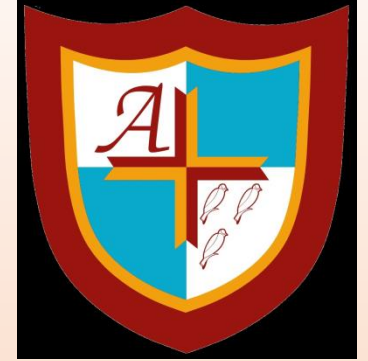
